1. Called to order at 5:50 PM
2. Visitors introduced including Board Trustee Carol Middel
3. The chairperson brought everyone up to date on the work of the Finance, Instruction, and Facilities Teams with a reference to the District's website for information provided to the public by the Communications Team
4. The chairperson began the meeting by updating the team on all on the work of the Instruction Team and the Facilities Team. A list of 17 elementary schools and the scores attributed to them based on a rubric designed by the Facilities Team was presented. A diagram bearing the recommended configuration of K-4 Elementary buildings, 5-6 Upper Elementary buildings, 7-8 Middle schools, and 9-12 High schools was shown. The diagram showed ten elementary schools, two upper elementary schools, two 7-8 middle schools, and two 9-12 high schools with William D. Ford Career Technical Center between the two high schools. It portrayed two identical feeder paths with five elementary schools feeding one upper elementary school, then one middle school, and finally one high school. In this manner, students entering the fifth

grade would remain with their classmates through their high school graduation.

5. Discussion ensued further about the rubric used by the Facilities Team regarding bus considerations, parking, recent construction, and improvements. Tony Spisak answered most of the questions. Scherice Roark addressed bussing.
6. Finally, consensus was reached to allow the chairperson and Mrs. Roark to work on potential boundaries taking into account the buildings with the highest scores from the Facilities Team.
7. It was later pointed out that work on middle schools cannot be done as yet. We need to wait for the Facilities team to complete its evaluation of those buildings.
8. Next meeting was scheduled for Monday, October 19, 2009 at 5:45 in Omega Room within the Special Education Department at the Administration Building.
9. The meeting was adjourned at approximately 7:10 PM.
