


Welcome to Wayne-Westland Community School's Elementary  for 2009-2010! This brochure has been created to guide you through lunch room policies and procedures for Elementary students during the 2009-2010 school year.

Breakfast

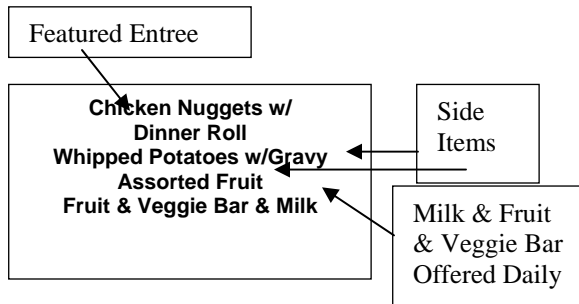
All Elementary Schools serve breakfast. Breakfast will cost \$1.40, and will consist of three items; a breakfast entrée, fruit side, and milk. Students who qualify for free or reduced lunches will also qualify for free or reduced price breakfast. Reduced breakfast is \$0.30.

Universal Breakfast

Universal Breakfast will be served at Elliott, Vandenberg, Jefferson, Hicks, & Taft. Universal Breakfast is a free breakfast served to all students in the classroom. Breakfast includes a main entrée, milk and fresh fruit or fruit juice. A Universal Breakfast Menu will be on the back of the lunch menu.

Menus

Menus are distributed to students before the beginning of each month, and include the following information: featured entree for each day, side items and lunch prices. The lunch price for 2009-2010 will be \$2.50. Milk will be sold for 50¢.



POS System

Students who purchase their lunch will make their purchases through the computerized Point of Sale (POS) system used in all of the District's cafeterias. Parents are encouraged to make pre-payments on their child's lunch account. Please make checks payable to **Wayne-Westland Community Schools**.

Snack Sales

In addition to a well-balanced meal, students may purchase snack items during lunch. All snacks offered through the Food Service Department meet guidelines established by the District's Wellness Policy. Snacks are offered as a supplement to student lunches, not as an alternative to a nutritious meal. Students who purchase multiple snacks on a single day are less likely to finish their lunch, and may decline to take their fruits or vegetables. Most snacks cost between \$.25 and \$1.00 and are cash sale only.

Lunch Room Etiquette

To maintain an orderly and efficient flow of students through the lunch line, students must be attentive and well behaved.



Each morning, students will select the lunch entrée they want to eat that day. It is important that students take the same entrée during lunch that they selected in their classroom in the morning. The kitchen staff prepares entrees based on morning student lunch counts. When students "switch" entrees it increases the chance that the kitchen will run out of the preferred selection for students at the end of the lunch line.

Federal guidelines do not require students to take every side item that is offered for lunch. However, the Food Service Department encourages students to take all side items that are offered with each meal. Students who pack their lunch may purchase milk or snacks in the serving area and are cash sale only.

Web Site

Free and Reduced Meals

If you are the parent of a free or reduced student, or think you may be eligible, please contact the District Office to find out how to apply. You MUST reapply at the beginning of each school year, regardless of the child's eligibility during the previous year. **Students who qualified for free or reduced meals last year will have a three week grace period at the beginning of school to reapply.** If an application is not submitted and approved for them by the end of that period, they will have to pay full price for their lunch until a new application has been submitted and approved.

Lunch charges

If a student forgets his or her lunch money, and charges their lunch, they are expected to repay the money for the charge on the following day. Students who have excessive outstanding charges will be limited to a plain cheese sandwich and milk until the charges are paid off. If a student continues to carry a negative balance, they may also lose their charging privileges in the future.
