



## Important H1N1 Vaccination Update 11-11-09

- Vaccination clinics at Schoolcraft and Hamtramck will have both injectables (shots) and Flumist (nasal spray). Come prepared to receive either one unless there are medical reasons for a specific vaccine.
- Individuals can download and complete a form to pre-register for mass vaccination clinics. Pre-registration is encouraged to expedite the vaccination process. Go to [www.waynecounty.com](http://www.waynecounty.com) and click on the H1N1 pre registration tab on the home page. Pre-registration does not guarantee vaccination.
- Individuals ages 6 month through 9 years old require two doses. If the first dose was received at the Hamtramck clinic on Saturday October 24<sup>th</sup> they **CAN NOT** receive the second dose on Saturday Nov. 14<sup>th</sup>. It is too early. The second dose must be 28 days pass the first dose.
