

Intra-County Schools of Choice Questions & Answers

1. *Who can apply?*
Students who reside in Wayne County and will be entering grades K-5 in the fall of 2008 are eligible to apply.
2. *Will the district provide transportation?*
No, transportation to and from school is the sole responsibility of the parent.
3. *What schools are accepting Intra-County Schools of Choice students?*
All 17 elementary schools are participating: Edison, Elliott, Graham, Hamilton, Hicks, Hoover, Jefferson-Barns, Kettering, Lincoln, Madison, Patchin, Roosevelt/McGrath, Schweitzer, Taft-Galloway, Vandenberg, Walker-Winter and Wildwood

Parents may indicate their top three choices of schools, but the district reserves the right to assign students to schools to best balance out classes.
4. *How do I apply?*
Applications are available from the Department of Instruction or online at <http://wwcsd.net>. Return application in person or by mail to the Department of Instruction, 36745 Marquette, Westland, Michigan 48185, 734.419.2083.
5. *What is the application deadline?*
All applications must be received in person or by mail by August 25, 2008.
6. *How will I know if my child is accepted?*
The Department of Instruction will review each application to see if it meets all requirements. Parents will then be notified by mail of their acceptance and the assigned school. Parents will then need to come into the Department of Instruction to complete the registration process.
7. *If my child is accepted for Intra-County Schools of Choice, will they have to re-apply next year?*
No, students accepted under Intra-County Schools of Choice remain in the district as long as they abide by the Student Code of Conduct.
8. *If I have more than one child, will they be placed at the same elementary school?*
The district will make an effort to place children from the same family at the same school whenever possible.
