

Emergency Drills

Let's be sure we are staying safe

Type of Drill

What Students Need to Do

Fire Drill 5 per year

When you hear the fire alarm, quickly get up from your seat and follow your teacher to the spot outside.

Do not worry about taking anything with you.

Make sure you are walking, not running, to the outdoor checkpoint.

Stay outside and wait for instructions from your teacher.

Tornado Drill 2 per year

When you hear the tornado warning, follow your teacher's directions. Depending on the classroom, you might move to the hallway or a different classroom.

Do not worry about taking anything with you.

When you reach your safe place, find a spot to sit on the floor. Cover the back of your head with your hands.

ALICE Safety Drill 3 per year

When you hear the announcement that there is an ALICE drill, follow your teacher's directions. We may be practicing one of four skills for the drill:

Alert Drill – Practice recognizing signs of danger and listening to information about potential dangers from others.

Inform Drill – Practice communicating information about dangerous situations using clear and direct language.

Evacuate Drill – Practice leaving dangerous situations through various exit points.

Lockdown Drill – Practice barricading (blocking) entry points and preparing to move to other skills as needed.
